## **Sports**

### **Student Eligibility**

All 5-8 students must have a minimum of a 2.0 GPA and/or be meeting or nearly meeting the California Common Core state standards in all subject areas. It is also important the 7-8 students maintain satisfactory progress toward meeting all promotion requirements from the prior grading period of the sport they wish to play to be eligible. (Education Code 35160.5) The Superintendent or designee may grant ineligible students a probationary period of not more than one trimester. Students granted a probationary period must meet the required standards by the end of the probationary period to remain eligible for participation. (BP 6145(a))

All students 5-8 must meet the school's academic and behavioral standards prior to the start of the athletic season. Students must have no "F" grades, and their Citizenship must be at least satisfactory or better. The Athletic Director will continually review grades and citizenship to determine eligibility. If a student has a "Needs Improvement" mark in Citizenship, it must be cleared by the teacher and principal. A student is unable to participate with an "Unsatisfactory" in any class.

Any student suspended for possession of alcohol, drugs, or fighting, or any kind of racial or sexual harassment, will automatically be removed from the team. All other suspensions and serious disciplinary actions are at the discretion of the principal.

The coach is never to play a student that has been rendered ineligible to play unless directed by the Athletic Director otherwise.

However, if a student has not regularly attended practices preceding the scheduled event/game, they can also be rendered ineligible to play by their coach. (BP 6145.2(s)).

- Physician's Statement/Medical Clearance**

Every student is required to provide a physician's statement, giving medical clearance to participate in after school sports. This form will stay on file through each year. A new clearance is required every year of participation.
