We are writing with an important update about schools and the role we all have in preventing the community spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus).

Sonoma County, along with Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, and Solano counties, has officially announced continued distance learning through May 1, 2020. This decision was based in consultation with the Sonoma County Public Health Officer and continues to follow the Governor's Shelter in Place order. This means students will continue learning from home through May 1st unless circumstances change regarding COVID-19.
